On February 14, 2011, Shaniqua [redacted] ("Complainant") filed a Verified Complaint ("Complaint") with the New York City Commission on Human Rights ("Commission") charging Continental [redacted] (collectively, "Respondents") with unlawful discriminatory practices in violation of Title 8 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York (the "Code").

Respondents deny the allegations of discrimination.

After investigation, the Commission has determined that there is NO PROBABLE CAUSE to believe that the Respondents have engaged or are engaging in the unlawful discriminatory practices alleged in the Complaint.


